

Re: Small Business Enterprise Certification

Dear Vendor:

Port Tampa Bay (PTB) welcomes your interest in the Small Business Enterprise (SBE) program. The PTB Board of Commissioners has adopted a policy to enhance contracting opportunities for SBE's in the PTB's construction, architecture, engineering, and goods and services contracts. The policy encourages the use of registered SBE firms to the greatest extent possible on all PTB projects. The PTB has a goal of nine-percent (9%) SBE participation for each contract.

The PTB invites your business to review the eligibly requirements listed below and if applicable complete the attached Vendor Registration Form. The SBE Policy as well as the Vendor Registration Form can be downloaded from the PTB website (www.porttb.com - Select: ABOUT THE PORT, Select: PROCUREMENT INFORMATION).

An eligible SBE is a business that meets the following requirements:

- Independently owned and operated, employs twenty-five (25) or fewer permanent full-time employees, and whose gross annual sales averaged over the previous three (3) year period is \$3,000,000 or less for goods and services or \$5,000,000 or less for Construction Services; and
- Been in business at least six (6) months before an SBE application for that entity will be considered.

Qualified business entities within the PTB's seven (7) county area may be considered for SBE status. The seven (7) county area includes: Hernando, Hillsborough, Manatee, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk and Sarasota Counties. Small businesses with a SBE certificate / registration with the City of Tampa or Hillsborough County may also be added to the PTB's SBE list.

Please return the completed registration form along with the documents listed below to the PTB Procurement Department:

- One copy of your entity's current Business Tax Receipt (formerly known as Occupational License);
- The first page of your entity's 1120S Tax Forms for the past three (3) years.

If the application is approved, a letter verifying registration and a SBE Certificate along with information regarding Onvia (also known as DemandStar; an electronic bidding notification system) will be sent to the firm. In addition the firm's name will be included in the SBE vendor directory which is available to all prospective bidders through the PTB website.
