### Port Tampa Bay Standard Work Permit Application #18-051 Mosaic d/b/a Tampa Port Services, LLC

#### Proposed Construction of a Seawall With Fill and Associated Mitigation

Location: 4873 Port Sutton Road, Tampa, Florida

Mosaic Fertilizer, LLC d/b/a Tampa Port Services, LLC has submitted an application to Port Tampa Bay for proposing shoreline stabilization improvements along Mosaic's southern shoreline to protect the existing anhydrous ammonia pipeline located along the top of bank. The proposed project consists of (i) constructing approximately 548 linear feet of new seawall, (ii) backfilling of approximately 3,349 cubic yards of clean material waterward of the mean high water elevation and (iii) placement of concrete scour matting to stabilize the upland slope. The project also includes 0.36 acres of impacts below mean high water elevation that will be mitigated through purchase of mitigation bank credits.

The project proposal is currently in review with the Environmental Protection Commission (EPC) of Hillsborough County and the project has been deemed consistent with the Hillsborough County Comprehensive Plan by the Hillsborough County City-County Planning Commission. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection has issued a corresponding permit for the project and an application is currently under review by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
