PORT TAMPA BAY STANDARD WORK PERMIT APPLICATION #20-028 WITH SUBMERGED LANDS LEASE AMENDMENT

SUBMITTED BY NR ROCKY POINT PROPERTY OWNER, LLC

NR Rocky Point Property Owner, LLC (NRRP) owns upland property located at 3015 N. Rocky Point Drive on Old Tampa Bay in Tampa, Florida and currently leases approximately 4,781 square feet of submerged land from Port Tampa Bay adjacent to the uplands for a multi-slip docking facility and in accordance with Port Tampa Bay's Standard Work Permit No. 20-028.

NRRP has submitted an application to Port Tampa Bay proposing to remove the existing multi-slip dock and construct a larger replacement private multi-family residential docking facility that consists of an approximately 4,608 square foot twelve (12) boat slip docking facility containing eight (8) non-covered boat lifts. NRRP desires to amend the existing Submerged Lands Lease to expand the leased premises to 11,874 square feet associated with construction of the replacement multi-slip docking facility.

Premises: Approximately 11,874 square feet of submerged lands.

Term: Existing lease is for five (5) years, which commenced on December

1, 2002, with four (4) lease extension options of five (5) years each.

Rent: Annual Rent is based upon the PTB Submerged Lands Management

Rules rate.

Use: The Premise is/will be used solely as a multi-slip docking facility and

is permitted to use Premises for any water dependent use incidental

of the primary use of NRRP's adjacent uplands property.

Other: NRRP shall be responsible for all real estate taxes, site

improvements, insurance, and maintenance of the Premises. In addition, NRRP shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations.

No other lease terms would be changed.

The project proposal is under review by the Environmental Protection Commission (EPC) of Hillsborough County and Hillsborough County City-County Planning Commission. The Southwest Florida Water Management District has issued a corresponding permit for this project and an application is currently under review by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
