## BACKGROUND INFORMATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING April 10, 2024 AT 9:30 A.M.

Port Tampa Bay Standard Work Permit Application #20-010
Submitted by Port Tampa Bay Engineering Department for Proposed Installation of 1,800-Feet Sheet Pile Bulkhead, Backfill 4.34 Acres Behind the Bulkhead Location and 3.2 acres of Maintenance Dredge at Berth 215 which will be used to Off-Load Cargo from Two Cargo Vessels; Berth 214/215 Adjacent to Port Sutton Entrance Channel, Tampa, FL

Port Tampa Bay Engineering Department proposes installation of 1,800 – Feet of Sheet Pile Bulkhead, Backfilling 4.34 acres and 3.2 acres of Maintenance Dredging at Berth 215 in Tampa, Florida. This project is for the waterfront development of Berth 214-215, located on the southern end of Hooker's Point. Construction will involve the placement of the 1,500 linear feet of steel sheet pile bulkhead along the shoreline, 300 feet of return wall, and the back filling of approximately 4 acres. Additionally, 3.16 of the previously permitted Berth 215 will be dredged to the depth of -43 feet plus two feet of over dredge.

## **FACTS/COMMENTS:**

The project has received recommendations for approval from the Environmental Protection Commission (EPC) of Hillsborough County for the wetland/surface water impact environmental review and has been deemed consistent with the *Imagine 2040: Tampa Comprehensive Plan* by the Hillsborough County City-County Planning Commission.
